



Dear Eastern High School Families:

At Eastern High School, we highly value and are committed to fostering a learning environment where students are safe and secure. A large part of that commitment is communicating potential safety issues with parents when they arise.

This morning, school administration was notified of police activity near the building. We contacted the Metropolitan Police Department (MPD) and immediately went into “lockdown” status, meaning all exterior doors were locked, and entry into the building was not permitted. MPD responded quickly, investigated the issue, and cleared us to resume normal activity within half an hour. While there was never an immediate threat to our school, we approach even the possibility of danger with extreme caution.
